

# MINUTES OF THE THIRD INTERNATIONAL WOOD ENGRAVING TRIENNIAL JURY MEETING ZAKOPANE 2014

## 1. General information:

The Jury meeting of the Third International Wood Engraving Triennial was held on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014 at the Antoni Kenar Art Schools in Zakopane.

# First stage of the Competition:

After a thorough analysis of all the received works, the Jury chose 30 works to take part in the second stage of the Competition including:

15 works in A category students of Lower Secondary School (13-15- year-old),

10 works in B category junior students of Secondary School (16-18- year-old),

5 works in C category senior students of Secondary School (19-20-year-old).

## **Second stage of the Competition:**

The Jury chose by voting works to take part in the final of the Competition including:

8 works in A category students of Lower Secondary School (13-15-year- old),

9 works in B category junior students of Secondary School (16-18-year-old),

5 works in C category senior students of Secondary School (19-20-year-old).

Among 22 works the Jury awarded the main prize - Grand Prix,

in A category (13-15- year-old): First, Second, Third Prize and Special Award established by the Head of the Tatra County as well as four equivalent honourable mentions.

in B category (16-18- year-old): First, Second, Third Prize and two Special Awards: by the prof. Zygmunt Januszewski Illustro Foundation and Zakopane Mayor as well as 3 equivalent honourable mentions.

in C category (19-20-year-old): First, Second, Third Prize and two equivalent honourable mentions.

The works qualified for the Competition, distinguished and awarded will be presented at the post competition exhibition. We cordially invite you to the Grand Opening of the Exhibition and the Award Ceremony which will be held at **16.00** hrs on **18 December 2014** in the Strug Gallery at the Antoni Kenar Art Schools in Zakopane, Kościeliska Street 35.

### 3. Conclusions:

The subsequent third edition of the International Wood Engraving Triennial organized by the Antoni Kenar Art Schools in Zakopane is an opportunity to present artistic personalities of the future graphic artists working in the oldest graphic technique – wood engraving. The technique is an inseparable element of the world cultural heritage. It was dominant in ancient China, Japan and finally became popular in Europe at the beginning of 14<sup>th</sup> century, where it mainly played an editorial role.

What is the reason of the present day interest in wood engraving in the times of the diversity of workshop graphics – intaglio techniques, so called metal, flat as lithography, serigraphy and presently dominant digital techniques? Is relief printing – wood engraving (often black and white) – an anachronism nowadays?

The question seems to have a more profound justification at present, because artists of many disciplines often tend not to give special importance to the workshop. What really counts for many of them is the message of an artwork and its proper reception. However, in the case of workshop graphics, both precision and the artist's sure hand are essential. A mistake made during the realisation of work of art cannot be corrected with a quick click of a mouse, as it is in the case of digital techniques, and the technological process itself, such as for instance print making, has remained unchanged for ages. Perhaps this is the reason why egalitarian workshop graphics has always had a limited circle of receivers appreciating its values as a work of art.

For many contemporary creators graphic techniques have one more discouraging feature - etching in a matrix is time consuming, and the material resistance of wooden or linoleum matrix imposes a certain synthesis of the form, which co-creates the power of expression. A lot depends on the mastery and workshop perfection, which results in the clarity and perfection of an artistic message.

The Competition is extremely important for me since it constitutes the continuation of a disappearing nowadays technique of relief printing – wood engraving, creating at the same time an opportunity for young artists to share their own creativity in this noble discipline of art. The proof of such a competition's popularity is the high number of competitors from many European and not only countries.

The Jury concluding the Third International Wood Engraving Triennial in Zakopane 2014 underlined the good level of entries as well as a wide interest in the organised Competition also beyond Poland.

Entries in A category - students of Lower Secondary School (13-15-year- old) presented a surprisingly high level, distinguishing themselves in a creative approach to such issues as composition and colour, as well as enthusiasm visible in many young artists. The number of entries in youth categories B and C was impressive, many of them presenting a very high technical workshop.
